Later see the State Capitol, the Governor's Mansion, China Town and view King Kamehameha's statue before returning to your hotel. Tonight enjoy a **Welcome Dinner** with your fellow Alumni travelers

Today enjoy a day at your leisure in paradise to soak up some sun on the beach or at the pool, do some shopping, play a round of golf or join an Optional Oahu Circle Island Tour.

### DAY 4: HONOLULU - FLY TO HILO (BIG ISLAND) - BIG ISLAND TOURING

This morning fly to Hilo on the Island of Hawaii (the Big Island). After settling in, travel to the nearby historic fishing village of Kailua Kona, referred to by the locals as Kona or Kona town.

This evening join your fellow travelers for a **Farewell Dinner** and say Aloha to the Islands as you enjoy a **Hawaiian Luau**, a fun filled cultural event featuring traditional food, dancing and music.
